In the matter of Order no. 17/2021-22 dated 15.09.2021 and Order no. 22/2021-22 dated 06.10.2021 regarding - Interim arrangement to levy the existing tariffs to continue beyond 31.03.2022.

This is regarding extension of interim arrangement to levy the existing tariffs beyond 31.03.2022 in respect of the following Airports as detailed in the tables below:

- (i) The tariff determination for 3rd Control Period is due for the above-mentioned airport. The Authority is already in receipt of MYTP in respect of GOA International Airport and the tariff determination exercise is currently under progress.
- (ii) Keeping in view that the tariff determination process will take some time, therefore, the Authority has decided that the existing tariff applicable as on 31.03.2022 may be extended for a further period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.04.2022 to 30.09.2022 or till the determination of tariffs for the 3rd Control Period, whichever is earlier.

- (ii) The MYTP in respect of other airports namely Jaipur, Guwahati & Trivandrum is awaited.
- (iii) Keeping in view that the tariff determination process will take more time, the Authority has decided that the existing tariff, applicable as on 31.03.2022 may be extended for a further period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.04.2022 to 30.09.2022 or till the determination of tariffs for the relevant Control Period, whichever is earlier.

<u>ORDER</u>

In view of the above, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008 hereby orders that:-

- (i) The **Airport Operators (listed at Table I & II above)** are allowed to levy the existing tariff, applicable as on 31.03.2022, on interim basis, for a further period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.04.2022 to 30.09.2022, or, till the determination of tariff for their respective Control Period, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operator shall ensure compliance of the Order.
