## Order No. 17/2021-22

AERA Building, Administrative Complex, Safdarjung Airport, New Delhi – 110003.

Date of Issue: 15th September, 2021

In the matter of Order no. 65/2020-21 dated 24.03.2021 regarding Economic Regulation of Aeronautical Services provided by Airport Operators - Interim arrangement to levy the existing tariffs to continue beyond 30.09.2021 for their respective Control Period.

This is regarding extension of interim arrangement to levy the existing tariffs beyond 30.09.2021 in respect of the following Airports as detailed in the table below:

#### I. AAI Airports:

- (i) The tariff determination for 3<sup>rd</sup> Control Period is due for the above mentioned airports. The Authority is already in receipt of MYTP/ATP in respect of all the above mentioned airports and the tariff determination process has been initiated.
- (ii) Keeping in view that the process will take more time, the Authority, has, decided that the tariff applicable as on 30.09.2021 may be extended for a further period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.10.2021 to 31.03.2022, or, till the determination of tariffs for the 3rd Control Period, whichever is earlier.

### II. PPP Airports:

- (i) The tariff determination for their respective Control Periods is due for the above mentioned airports. The Authority is in receipt of MYTP/ATP in respect of Mangaluru & Lucknow Airports and the MYTP/ATP in respect of Ahmedabad Airport is awaited.
- (ii) Keeping in view that the process will take more time, the Authority has decided that the existing tariff, applicable as on 30.09.2021, may be extended for a further



period of six (06) months w.e.f. 01.10.2021 to 31.03.2022, or, till the determination of tariffs for the relevant Control Period, whichever is earlier.

#### **ORDER**

In view of the above, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airport Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008 hereby orders that:-

- (i) The Airport Operators (listed at Table I & II above) are allowed to levy the existing tariff, applicable as on 30.09.2021, on interim basis, for a further period of 06 (six) months w.e.f. 01.10.2021 to 31.03.2022, or, till the determination of tariff for their respective Control Period, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operator may ensure compliance of the Order.
