In the matter of Determination of ad-hoc Tariff for Ground Handling Services to be provided by M/s IndoThai Calicut Private Limited, at Calicut International Airport, Kozhikode for the period from 01.06.2022 to 30.09.2022.

M/s IndoThai Calicut Private Limited (ICPL) vide letter dated 24.09.2021 informed the Authority that M/s Indo Thai Airport Management Services Pvt. Ltd. was issued a Letter of Intent (LOI) dated 19.02.2021 by Airports Authority of India (AAI) for Concession for Ground Handling Services at Calicut International Airport. As per clause 5 of the LOI, a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) namely "IndoThai Calicut Pvt. Ltd" has been incorporated on 19.03.2021.

2. In continuation to their letter dated 24.09.2021, M/s ICPL submitted copies of following documents to the Authority vide letter dated 18.04.2022:

- (i) LOI No. AAI/OPS/GHS/12/B1/2020/77 dated 19.02.2021
- (ii) Certificate of Incorporation of SPV "IndoThai Calicut Pvt. Ltd"

(iii) Security clearance issued by Bureau of Civil Aviation Security

(iv) Concession agreement entered between M/s IndoThai Calicut Pvt Ltd. and AAI.

3. M/s ICPL requested the Authority to allow it to charge the same Tariff, as approved for the other Ground Handling Service Provider at Calicut International Airport, namely, Air India Airport Services Ltd. (AIASL), on ad-hoc basis, from the date of commencement of its Operations at Calicut International Airport w.e.f. 01.06.2022.

4. The Authority notes that M/s ICPL has obtained BCAS Security Clearance vide BCAS order dated 12.07.2021, valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of security clearance or the period of validity of contract with the airport operator, whichever is earlier. The Authority also notes that the Airport Operator, AAI) executed Concession Agreement with ICPL on 19.07.2021.

5. The Authority, having examined the request of ICPL, notes that submission of MYTP by the ISP and issuance of Tariff Order by the Authority will take some time. The Authority, in the interim, has decided to allow M/s IndoThai Calicut Pvt. Ltd., to levy the existing Tariff, as approved for the other Ground Handling Service Provider at Calicut International Airport, namely, Air India Airport Services Ltd. (refer Order nos. 18/2019-20 dated 22.11.2019, which was further extended vide Interim Order nos. 67/2020-21 dated 25.03.2021, 18/2021-22 dated 15.09.2021 & 46/2021-22 dated 17.03.2022), on ad-hoc basis, w.e.f. 01.06.2022 to 30.09.2022, or, till the determination of regular Ground Handing Tariff, whichever is earlier.

ORDER

Upon careful consideration of the material available on records, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) M/s IndoThai Calicut Pvt. Ltd. is allowed to levy and collect, on ad hoc basis, the existing Tariff, as approved for the other Ground Handling Service Provider, namely, Air India Airport Services Ltd. (AIASL) at Calicut International Airport as per attached Tariff Card at Annexure-I, w.e.f. 01.06.2022 to 30.09.2022, or, till the determination of regular Ground Handing Tariff for the 3rd Control Period, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Tariff charged by M/s IndoThai Calicut Pvt. Ltd. for Non-Scheduled Operations shall not exceed the Tariff approved by the Authority for Scheduled Operations for 'similar class of aircraft(s).'
- (iii) Tariff approved, as above, will be the maximum Tariff to be charged from the Users of the Ground Handling Services. No other charges are to be levied over and above the approved Tariff.
- (iv) The Airport Operator shall ensure compliance of the Order.
