In the matter of Determination of Ad-hoc Tariff for Domestic Cargo Handling Services provided by M/s AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company Limited at Mangaluru International Airport, Mangaluru.

AAICLAS Submission

- 1. AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company Limited (AAICLAS) is a wholly owned subsidiary of Airports Authority of India (AAI) performing Aviation Cargo Business in India. AAI demerged and corporatized its cargo department into a functionally and administratively independent organization named as "AAICLAS," and incorporated on 11th August, 2016. Presently, AAICLAS is providing Cargo Services at 17 major airports, including Mangaluru International airport.
- 2. M/s AAICLAS, vide letter dated 02.06.2022, informed the Authority that Cargo Service Center Ltd. (CSC) had operated the Domestic Cargo Terminal at Mangaluru airport from 26.06.2015 to 25.06.2020 under the leasing agreement with AAICLAS. Subsequently, M/s AAICLAS took over the Domestic Cargo Terminal at Mangaluru airport and started providing Domestic Cargo Services with the Tariff Rates as applicable to AAI's Non-Major Airports as per letter no. AV-16026/159/2015-ER dated 19.05.2016 issued by the Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA).



- 3. Consequent to declaration of Mangaluru International Airport as a "Major Airport" in terms of Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, vide MoCA notification dated 10.01.2020, M/s AAICLAS has informed that the preparation of MYTP is under process and will be submitted to the Authority shortly for determination of regular Aeronautical Tariff for Cargo Services at Mangaluru International Airport.
- 4. M/s AAICLAS, in the meantime, seeks an interim Tariff for its Domestic Cargo Operations at Mangaluru Airport, based on the prevailing Tariff approved for Non-Major Airports by MoCA.

Authority's Analysis

- 5. The Authority notes that AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company Limited (AAICLAS) is a wholly owned subsidiary of Airports Authority of India (AAI) and operating in Aviation Cargo Business in India. AAICLAS has got the required Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) approval for its Domestic Cargo Operation at the Mangaluru International Airport, Mangaluru vide BCAS letter dated 03.02.2022. The BCAS Security clearance is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of Security Programme i.e. up to 02.02.2027.
- 6. The Authority notes that M/s AAICLAS is currently operating at Domestic Cargo Terminal at Mangaluru International Airport, with the Tariff Rates applicable for Non-Major Airports as per letter no. AV-16026/159/2015-ER dated 19.05.2016 issued by MoCA.
- 7. The Authority, having examined the request of AAICLAS, notes that submission of Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) for the determination of regular Tariff for Domestic Cargo Services at Mangaluru airport from the ISP is expected shortly. However, regulatory process for determination of regular Tariff for the proposed Cargo Services at Mangaluru airport, including issuances of Consultation Paper & Tariff Order will take some time. Therefore, the Authority, in the interim, decides to allow M/s AAICLAS, to levy the prevailing tariff as per MoCA approval vide letter no. AV-16026/159/2015-ER dated 19.05.2016, on ad hoc basis, as per Annexure-I, up to 31.03.2023, or, till the determination of regular Tariff for Cargo Handling Services, whichever is earlier.

Order

Upon careful consideration of the material available on records, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) M/s AAICLAS is allowed to levy, on Ad-hoc basis, Tariff for Domestic Cargo Handling Services at Mangaluru International Airport, Mangaluru as per Annexure-1 for a period up to 31.03.2023, or, till the determination of regular Tariff for Domestic Cargo Handling Services for the First Control Period, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) Tariff approved, as above, will be the maximum Tariff to be charged from the Users of the Cargo Handling Services. No other charges are to be levied over and above the approved Tariff.
- (iii) The Tariff determined herein above is excluding of applicable taxes, if any.



(iv) The Airport Operator shall ensure compliance of the Order.

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- 7. Charges will be levied on the 'gross weight' or the chargeable weight' of the consignment, whichever is higher. Wherever the 'gross weight' and (or) 'volume weight' is wrongly indicated on the Airway Bill and is found more, charges will be levied on the 'actual gross weight' or 'actual volumetric weight', whichever is higher.
- 8. For mis-declaration of weight above 2% and up to 5% of declared weight, penal charges @ double the applicable domestic cargo handling charges and for variation above 5%, the penal charges @ 5 times the applicable domestic cargo handling charges will be leviable on the differential weight, subject to minimum amount equivalent to the applicable minimum domestic cargo handling Charges. No penal charges will be leviable for variation up to and inclusive of 2%. No weight deviation permissible in VAL cargo.
- 9. XBIS usage charges INR 1.00 per kg subject to minimum of INR 150.00 per shipment. The same is applicable at 50% per kg subject to minimum of INR 100.00 per ODC shipment where physical checks with the help of ETDs are facilitated. However, in random check cases in ETDs by airlines after scanning through XBIS, no charges to be levied for usage of ETDs.
- 10. Any other agencies operating at airport utilizing AAICLAS equipment like Forklift, Tractor and any other equipment shall be charged separately.
- 11. All bills shall be rounded up to the nearest higher of Rupee 1.00. (Eg. 1.25 = 2.00; 3.85 = 4.00)
- 12. The Tariff Rates indicated herein above are excluding of all applicable taxes, if any.
- 13. Tariff determined as above will be maximum Tariff to be charged from the Users of the Cargo Handling Services. No other charges to be levied over and above the approved Tariff.

- 9. All bills shall be rounded up to the nearest higher of Rupee 1.00. (Eg. 1.25 = 2.00; 3.85 = 4.00)
- 10. The Tariff Rates indicated herein above are excluding of all applicable taxes, if any.
- 11. Tariff determined as above will be maximum Tariff to be charged from the Users of the Cargo Handling Services. No other charges to be levied over and above the approved Tariff.
