In the matter of Determination of ad-hoc Tariff for Domestic and International Cargo Handling Services provided by M/s AAICLAS, at Srinagar International Airport, Srinagar

### AAICLAS Submission

1. AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company Limited (AAICLAS) is a wholly owned subsidiary promoted by Airports Authority of India (AAI) operating in Aviation Cargo Business in India. AAI demerged and corporatized its cargo department into a functionally and administratively independent organization named as "AAICLAS," and incorporated on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2016. Presently, AAICLAS is providing Cargo Services at 17 major airports, including Srinagar International Airport.

2. M/s AAICLAS, vide letter dated 02.06.2022, informed the Authority that AAICLAS is operating at Srinagar International Airport and providing Domestic Cargo Services w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2022 and International Cargo Services w.e.f. 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2022, with the Tariff Rates as applicable to AAI's Non-Major Airports as per letter no. AV-16026/159/2015-ER dated 19.05.2016 issued by Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA).



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3. Consequent to declaration of Srinagar Airport as a "Major Airport" in terms of Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, vide MoCA notification dated 05.11.2021, M/s AAICLAS informed that the preparation of Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) for Cargo Services at Srinagar International Airport is in process and same will be submitted shortly to the Authority.

4. M/s AAICLAS, in the meantime, seeks an interim Tariff for its Domestic and International Cargo Operations at Srinagar International Airport, based on the prevailing Tariff approved for Non-Major Airports by MoCA.

#### Authority's Analysis

5. The Authority notes that AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company Limited (AAICLAS) is a wholly owned subsidiary promoted by Airports Authority of India (AAI) and operates in Aviation Cargo Business in India. AAICLAS has got the required Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS) approval for its Domestic & International Cargo Operations at Srinagar Airport, vide BCAS letter dated 24.02.2022. The BCAS security clearance is valid for a period of 5 years i.e. up to 23.02.2027, from the date of issue of Security Programme.

6. The Authority notes that M/s AAICLAS is currently providing Domestic and International Cargo Services at Srinagar International Airport, with the Tariff Rates applicable for AAI's Non-Major Airports as per letter no. AV-16026/159/2015-ER dated 19.05.2016 issued by MoCA.

7. The Authority, having examined the request of AAICLAS, feels that submission of Multi Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP) for the determination of regular Tariff for Domestic and International Cargo Services at Srinagar Airport will take some time. The Authority, in the interim, decides to allow M/s AAICLAS, to levy the prevailing tariff for Cargo Services as per MoCA approval vide letter no. AV-16026/159/2015-ER dated 19.05.2016, on ad hoc basis, as per Annexure-I, up to 31.03.2023, or, till the determination of regular Tariff for Cargo Handling Services, whichever is earlier.

## Order

Upon careful consideration of the material available on records, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that:

- (i) M/s AAICLAS is allowed to levy, on ad hoc basis, the Tariff for Domestic & International Cargo Handling Services at Srinagar International Airport as per Annexure-I up to 31.03.2023, or, till the determination of regular Cargo Handing Tariff for the 1<sup>st</sup> Control Period, whichever is earlier.
- (ii) Tariff approved, as above, will be the maximum Tariff to be charged from the Users of the Cargo Handling Services. No other charges are to be levied over and above the approved Tariff.
- (iii) The Tariff determined herein above is excluding of applicable taxes, if any.



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(iv) The Airport Operator shall ensure compliance of the Order.

- 2. 10% discount in the Terminal, Storage and Processing charges will be granted to Exporters, who opt for engaging their own manpower for offloading cargo from their vehicles at Truck Dock and shifting to Custom Examination Area and handing over to Airlines/Terminal Operator, wherever it is applicable.

Wherever the 'gross weight' and (or) 'volume weight' is wrongly indicated on the Airway Bill and is found more, charges will be levied on the 'actual gross weight' or 'actual volumetric weight', whichever is higher.
- 8. For mis-declaration of weight above 2% and up to 5% of declared weight, penal charges (a) double the applicable Terminal, Storage and Processing charges and for variation above 5%, the penal charges (a) 5 times the applicable Terminal, Storage and Processing charges will be leviable on the differential weight, subject to minimum amount equivalent to the applicable minimum Terminal, Storage and Processing charges. No penal charges



will be leviable for variation up to and inclusive of 2%. (For any variation, all the documents/records to be invariably amended). No weight variation acceptable in the case of VAL consignments.

- 9. Valuable cargo consists of gold, bullion, currency notes, securities, shares, share coupons, travelers' cheques, diamonds (including diamonds for industrial use), diamond jewellery, jewellery & watches made of silver, gold platinum and items valued at USD 1000 per Kg. & above.
- Terminal Operator shall levy packing/repacking charges @ 2% of packages per shipping bill with a minimum of INR 20.00 per Airway Bill. Packing / Repacking charges will be at INR 10.00 per packet.
- 11. XBIS usage charges INR 1.00 per kg subject to minimum of INR 150.00 per shipment. The same is applicable at 50% per kg subject to minimum of INR 100.00 per ODC shipment where physical check with the help of ETDs are facilitated. However, in random check cases in ETDs by airlines after scanning through XBIS, no charges to be levied for usage of ETDs.
- 12. Charges shall be leviable separately for installation/ commissioning/ maintenance of Air Cargo Inspection System (ACIS) as stipulated by CBIC as & when implemented.
- 13. As an incentive to trade to utilize the lean hours, 20% discount in the Terminal, Storages and processing charges will be granted to Export cargo admitted between 1000 hours to 1500 hours, subject to levy of minimum rate per consignment as given in scale of charges.
- 14. Merchant Over Time (MOT) charges @ INR 250/- per consignment for admitting cargo beyond Normal Working hours, wherever 24x7 export cargo operation does not exist.
- 15. The export TSP charges paid in advance **through online** by the shippers/ agents will be refunded in case the export cargo is not physically brought to the Air Cargo Terminal for processing on the same day subject to retention of minimum rate per consignment of General/ Special/ Valuable cargo respectively. Proportionate Applicable GST on minimum rate will also be retained.
- 16. For the Export Cargo withdrawal from the examination area, withdrawal demurrage charge will be collected equivalent to examination area demurrage charges. Similarly, for the withdrawal of export cargo from the bonded area, bonded area demurrage charges will be collected.
- 17. No X-Ray charges leviable for the Custom cleared Export Cargo moving by bonded trucks to other destinations.
- 18. Any other agencies operating at airport utilizing AAICLAS equipment like Forklift, Tractor and any other equipment shall be charged separately.
- 19. All bills shall be rounded up to the nearest higher of Rupee 1.00. (e.g. 1.25 = 2.00; 3.85 = 4.00)
- 20. The Tariff Rates indicated herein above are excluding of all applicable taxes, if any.
- 21. Tariff determined as above will be maximum Tariff to be charged from the Users of the Cargo Handling Services. No other charges to be levied over and above the approved Tariff.

(04 working days), from the date and time of segregation reflected in the ICEGATE. If clearance is affected after 96 hrs.
