The Authority, vide Interim Order No.24/2022-23 dated 23.09.2022, approved on ad hoc basis, extension of the existing tariff (as on 30.09.2022) in respect of M/s CONCOR Air Limited (CAL) for a further period up to 31.12.2022.

2. Subsequent to issuance of the aforesaid Interim Order on 23.09.2022, M/s CONCOR Air Ltd. (CAL) vide email dated 28.12.2022 submitted the followings:

- (i) That Mumbai International Airport Limited (Airport Operator) vide their letter No. MIAL/CARGO/CONCOR/2022-23 dated 19.12.2022 has further extended the support period up to 31.03.2023 and requested M/s CAL to continue its Cargo Handling Operations up to 31.03.2023.
- (ii) In view of the further extension of their Cargo Handling Operations at CSMIA, Mumbai up to 31.03.2023, M/s CAL requests the Authority to extend the prevailing Tariff (as on 31.12.2022) for period up to 31.03.2023.

3. The Authority examined the submission of the ISP taking into considering the extension of the existing arrangement between Airport Operator and the ISP for continuation of Domestic Cargo Handling operations by CAL at CSMIA, Mumbai, decides to extend the tariff as applicable as on 31.12.2022 for further three months i.e. up to 31.03.2023.

<u>ORDER</u>

In view of the above, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, hereby orders that: -

M/s CONCOR Air.Ltd. is allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariff, applicable as on 31.12.2022, for a further period of three (03) months w.e.f **01.01.2023 to 31.03.2023**.
