In the matter of Order No. 43/2018-19 dated 28.03.2018 regarding Economic Regulation of Aeronautical Services provided by Airport Operators/ Independent Service providers of Cargo facility, Ground Handling and Supply of Fuel to the aircraft - Interim arrangement to continue the levy of existing tariffs beyond 30.09.2018 for the Second Control Period.

This is regarding interim arrangement of levy of tariff for the period beyond 30.09.2018 of the Second Control Period (FY 2016-17 to FY 2020-21) in respect of Airport Operator(s) and Independent Service Provider(s) mentioned in the table below:

2. The Authority is in process of scrutinizing the MYTP/ATP submission received from various Airport Operators/Independent Service Providers viz. Cargo Operations, Ground Handling Agencies and Into Plane Service Providers and the determination process is likely to take some time. Hence, the Authority has decided that the Airport Operators/Independent Services Providers at List **A** and **B** (SI. No. 1 to 15) above, may be allowed to continue the levy of the tariffs existing as on 30.09.2018 for a period of six months w.e.f. 01.10.2018 to 31.03.2019 or till determination of tariffs for the second control period, whichever is earlier.

3. As regards, new ISPs at SI, No: 16 to 20 (List C), the Authority has decided that these Independent Services Providers may be allowed to continue the levy of the existing tariffs as on 30.09.2018 for a period of six months w.e.f. 01.10.2018 to 31.03.2019 or till determination of tariffs for the second control period, whichever is earlier.

<u>ORDER</u>

In view of the above, to avoid any regulatory vacuum in respect of the tariffs being levied by the regulated entities, the Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1) of the Airport Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008 hereby orders that:-

- (i) The Airport Operators/ Independent Service Providers as per list A, B and C (SI. No. 1 to 20) as above may be allowed to continue levy of tariffs existing as on 30.09.2018, for a further period of six months w.e.f. 01.10.2018 to 31.03.2019 or till determination of tariffs for the Second Control Period whichever is earlier.
- (ii) The Airport Operators may also ensure compliance of the Order in respect of the Independent Service Providers at the respective major airports.
