Annual Tariff Proposal for Second tariff year of M/s Bhadra International India Pvt Ltd. for Ground Handling Services provided at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata

New Delhi: 19th June, 2012

AERA Building Administrative Complex Safdarjung Airport New Delhi – 110 003 The Authority had considered the Multi-Year Tariff Proposal, for the first control period along with the Annual Tariff Proposal for the first tariff year of the control period, (i.e. 2011-12) submitted by Bhadra in respect of ground handling services provided at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata. After due stakeholder consultation, the Authority passed the Multi Year Tariff Order (MYTO) No.30/2011-12 dated 28.11.2011 ordering that:


- (i) The services provided for ground handling at NSCBI Airport by Bhadra International India Limited, are "not material". Hence the Authority shall adopt light touch approach for determination of tariff during the first control period of 5 years commencing 01.04·2011.
- (ii) The tariff for the ground handling services provided by Bhadra at NSCBI Airport at Kolkata is determined w.e.f. 1.04·2011.
- 2. Bhadra vide its letter no. Nil dated 10.04.2012 forwarded the Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for the second tariff year (i.e. 2012-13) of the first Control Period with tariff-rate card proposed for year 2012-13. In the ATP they have stated that they 'would be maintaining the same rates with higher and lower end limits, as submitted for the 1st tariff year which has been duly approved by the Authority vide Order no. 30/2011-12 dated 05.12.2011 for Kolkata airport'. (Annexure I)
- 3.1 As per para 7.4 of the Authority's Guidelines [Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff for Services Provided for Cargo Facility, Ground Handling and Supply of fuel to the Aircraft) Guidelines, 2011] after issuance of the Multi year tariff order, the service provider shall submit the Annual Tariff proposal at least 75 days prior to the start of tariff year. In the instant case, Bhadra should have submitted their second year annual tariff proposal, i.e. for the financial year 2012-13, starting w.e.f. 01.04.2012, by 16.01.2012.
- 3.2 As per clause A.I.8.2., of the Appendix to the Guidelines for Regulated Service(s) deemed either 'not material' or 'material but competitive' or 'material and not competitive' but where the Authority is assured of the reasonableness of the existing User Agreement(s), the Service Providers(s) shall submit, for the consideration of the Authority, an Annual Tariff Proposal for review of Tariff(s) to be charged in the following Tariff Year for the Control Period, in the specified Form B and Form F14 (b). The Tariff(s), as proposed by the Service Provider in the Annual Tariff Proposal, shall be on non- discriminatory basis, with reference to conditions of Tariff(s), volume of the discount, rationale behind giving the discount and such other factors as may be relevant.
- 4.1 Bhadra, in their proposal for Second tariff year, submitted the following:
 - (a) Form B duly signed
 - (b) Form 14 (b) duly stamped.
- 4.2 As already brought out vide para 2, Bhadra, in their ATP submission, stated that they would be maintaining the rates that have been approved by the Authority vide Order no.30/2011-12 dated 05.12.2011 in respect of their ground handling services at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata.

- 4.3 The tariffs for first tariff year for Ground handling service provided by Bhadra at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata as determined by the Authority, vide Order No. 30/2011-12 dated 05.12.2011 are placed at (**Annexure-II**).
- 5. The Authority carefully considered the proposal submitted by Bhadra for Ground Handling services being provided by them at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata and decided to make the following proposal for stakeholder consultation:
 - (i) The tariffs for the second tariff year (i.e.2012-13), for Ground Handling services provided by M/s Bhadra International India Pvt Ltd. at NSCBI Airport, Kolkata may be determined at the same rates determined vide Authority Order no. 30 /2011-12 dated 05.12.2011.
 - (ii) Tariff proposed as above will be maximum and will be effective from 01.04.2012.
- 6. In accordance with the provisions of Section 13(4) of the AERA Act, the proposal contained in para 5 above is hereby put forth for stakeholder consultation. To assist the stakeholders in making their submissions in a meaningful and constructive manner, necessary documents are enclosed as Annexure I & II. For removal of doubts; it is clarified that the contents of this Consultation Paper may not be construed as any Order or Direction of this Authority. The Authority shall pass an Order, in the matter, only after considering the submissions of the stakeholders in response hereto and by making such decision fully documented and explained in terms of the provisions of the Act.
- 7. The Authority welcomes written evidence-based feedback, comments and suggestions from stakeholders on the proposal made in para 5 above, latest by **03.07.2012** at the following address:
