In the matter of determination of aeronautical tariffs in respect of Trivandrum International Airport, Thiruvananthapuram (TVM) for the second control period (01.04.2016-31.03.2021).

- The Authority vide Order no. 03/2017-18 dated 02.06.2017 determined the tariffs in respect of Trivandrum Airport, Thiruvananthapuram for the second control period effective from 01.07.2017.
- Subsequent to the issue of Order, AAI has requested AERA for insertion of following clause in Tariff Card regarding collection charges of UDF.

2.1

"If the Payment is made within 15 days of receipt of invoice, then collection charges at Rs 5 per departing passenger shall be paid by AAI. No collection charges shall be paid in case the airline fails to pay the UDF invoice to AAI within the credit period of 15 days or in case of any part payment. To be eligible to claim this collection charges, the airlines should have no overdue on any account with AAI".

ORDER

The Authority, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 13(1)(a) of the Airports Economic Regulatory Authority of India Act, 2008, and the facts and clarifications placed on record before the Authority, decides and orders that:

The clause at Para 2.1 above may be read with notes to User Development Fees (UDF) of Tariff Card for the respective years.
