Sub: Annual Tariff Proposal (ATP) for the Third Control Period (FY2022-2026) for SVPIA.

Ref: Consultation Paper No. 10/2022-23 dated 20th October 2022 (CP) in the matter of determination of aeronautical tariff for Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport (SVPIA) for the Third Control Period (TCP).

Dear Sir,

This has reference to the subject CP published by the Authority, in the matter of determination of aeronautical tariffs for Ahmedabad International Airport Limited (AIAL) who is an operator of SVPIA for the Third Control Period beginning from 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2026.

At the outset, AIAL and Adani group would like to appreciate the hard work put in by the Authority while conducting the due diligence of our MYTP for the TCP and releasing the CP of AIAL in a timebound manner.

AIAL would be submitting detailed responses w.r.t the proposals put forth by the Authority in the CP as part of the stakeholders consultation process within the stipulated period. We request Authority to kindly consider our submissions/responses while finalizing the Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR) for the TCP and provide AIAL an opportunity to revise the ATP, prior to issuing final order based on the final decision of the Authority.

After a detailed planning, with the vision to transform Ahmedabad as a gateway to western India, we hereby submit ATP for SVPIA as under:-

1. The effective date for the revised tariff implementation has been considered as 1st February 2023 for the purpose of ATP.
2. The rate cards proposed by AIAL are provided as :-
 - a. **Annexure A** - Landing and Parking, User Development Fees (UDF)
 - b. **Annexure B** - Domestic and International cargo handling services
 - c. **Annexure C** - Integrated Fuel Storage and Into Plane (ITP) Services
3. While calculating the Target revenues in present value terms and to propose the new tariff card, AIAL has appropriately assumed the recovery of various revenue streams till 31st Jan 2023 as per existing applicable tariff cards as approved by the Authority time to time as follows :-
 - a. Order No. 52/2020-21 dated 06th November 2020 approving the levy of the Aeronautical Charges and its extension from time to time.

- b. Order no. 52/2020-21 dated 06th November 2020 and Order No. 01/2021-22 23rd June 2021, approving the charges for domestic cargo and international cargo handling services respectively and its extension from time to time.
 - c. Order No. 16/2022-23 dated 01st August 2022 approved for Ad-hoc Tariff for Integrated Fuel Storage and Into Plane (ITP) Services to be provided by AIAL at SVPIA
4. AIAL has considered the billable traffic (**refer Annexure D for calculation of billable traffic**) which is derived based on the total traffic as considered in the CP.
5. As directed by the Authority under point 7.3.82 and 7.3.135 of CP, AIAL has considered the future projection of revenues from Hangers & Annex Building and GSE Maintenance Facility while arriving at the above rate card (**refer Annexure E**), in addition to other aeronautical revenues streams like CUTE and Ground Handling
6. We hereby request AERA to kindly allow True-Up of the shortfall in the next control period along with necessary carrying cost, if any.

While, the recovery trend and future path of the traffic is robust, one cannot predict the unexpected events like COVID-19, which can be detrimental to aviation ecosystem as whole. We would request the Authority to provide us an opportunity at the end of March-2024 to revise the ATP (without redoing the entire tariff determination process) so as to achieve the final ARR determined for the TCP.

Annexure A - Landing, Parking, UDF Charges

General

1. Weight of an aircraft means MTOW in MT (i.e. 1000 Kg) as indicated in the Certificate of Airworthiness (CoA) – for each aircraft in the airlines' fleet.
2. Rates mentioned below are applicable from 00:00 Hours of 1st February 2023.

Landing Charges

Below mentioned rates are Rack Rates (RR), wherever necessary in the tariff order. The landing charges will be levied per landing as per the nature of the flight operations and MTOW of the aircraft used for operations.

Exemption in Landing Charges and Parking Charges

1. Scheduled domestic flights operated by scheduled Indian airlines with aircraft having less than 80 seats are exempt from paying Landing Charges.
2. Training flights operated by DGCA approved flying schools/flying training institutes are exempted from paying Landing Charges.
3. Helicopters operated by Indian operators are exempted from paying Landing and Parking charges.
4. Military aircraft (Government of India) including para-military forces such as BSF, Coast Guard etc. are exempted from paying Landing and Parking charges.
5. RCS UDAN flights are exempted from paying Landing, Parking and UDF charges, however the applicable charges will be governed as per the below table:

Exemptions in Payment of User Development Fee (UDF)

The following categories of passengers are exempted from levy of UDF:

1. Children (Under the age of 2 years)
2. Holders of Diplomatic Passport.
3. Airlines crew on duty including sky marshals and airline crew on board for the particular flight only (this would not include Dead Head Crew, or ground personnel),
4. Persons travelling on official duty on aircraft operated by Indian Armed Forces.
5. Persons travelling on official duty for United Nations Peace Keeping Missions.
6. Transit/transfer passengers (this exemption may be granted to all the passengers transiting up to 24 hrs from arrival into airport and is part of the same ticket, in case 2 separate tickets are issued it would not be treated as transit passenger)
7. Passengers Embarking from the Indian airports due to involuntary re-routing i.e. technical problems or weather conditions.

Currency Conversion

For conversion of US \$ denominated charges into INR, the same shall be based as per exchanged rate (RBI Reference Rate) as on the first day of the billing period.



Variable Tariff Plan for Scheduled Passenger Airlines

Under the category listed below, AIAL proposes a Variable Tariff Plan (VTP), that will be applicable for scheduled international passenger airlines.

Definition of Category

1. **Existing flights:** Flights that are currently being operated at Ahmedabad
2. **New Route:** A flight to a new destination that is currently unserved from Ahmedabad by any airline already operating at Ahmedabad. (Destination must be unserved for the previous 36 months) to / from regions of Africa, Europe/US and Far East.
E.g. Airline A introduces a new route Ahmedabad-Male, which is currently unserved from Ahmedabad by any airline.

Validity

The VTP for applicable international flights is valid from the date of commencement of operations and for the duration of 36 months for new international route.

Notes

1. No discount over and above the Variable Tariff Plan is applicable.
2. VTP is applicable only for scheduled passenger and freighter airlines, as applicable in the table above
3. Scheduled airline must operate VTP eligible flights for a minimum of 42 weeks within a rolling 12-month period to qualify for the incentive.
4. The payment of landing charges should be done by the airline in full without any deductions, as per the invoicing by Ahmedabad International Airport Limited. The settlement shall be provided in the form of a 'Credit Note' at the end of each 12-month period.
5. Ahmedabad International Airport Limited reserves the right to change any term or condition of this VTP, withdraw or replace any of the category, at any time at its absolute discretion, by way of prior notification through an appropriate channel.

**General Condition**

1. All above mentioned charges (Landing, Parking, UDF) are exclusive of applicable taxes.
2. UDF charges are applicable for tickets issued on or after the effective date of the tariff order
3. All the charges to Indian Carriers (including international operations) will be done in INR terms and to international carriers in USD terms.
4. Invoice for the above charges shall be raised by the Airport Operator on weekly basis and the invoice shall include applicable taxes.
5. For all the above charges, the Airlines will be allowed a credit period as may be decided by AIAL from time to time, subject to approval of credit limits by AIAL.
6. If the invoice for any of the airport charges is not paid within the credit period, interest shall be charged at the rate of one and half percent (1.5%) per month and shall be charged on pro-rata basis for each day of delay.
7. Payment received from the airlines shall first be appropriated towards the interest due in case of overdue and unpaid invoices. Thereafter, surplus/remaining amount, if any, shall be applied towards principal dues in chronological
