Attention of all concerned is invited to Consultation Paper No. 14/2013-14 dated 26.06.2013, issued by the Authority in the matter of "Determination of Aeronautical Tariffs" in respect of Bengaluru International Airport, Bengaluru for the first control period (01.04.2011 - 31.03.2016) and subsequent Public Notice No. 4/2013-14 dated 02.08.2013 vide which the last date of submission of comments was extended upto 19.08.2013.


2. In this regard, letter has been received from BIAL dated 14.08.2013 wherein it has requested for extension of time of 3 weeks from 19th August 2013. It had earlier sent a letter dated 30.07.2013 stating that:

"In order to reach to a workable solution, BIAL intends to agree with the tariff on hybrid till model and accordingly is in the process of submitting calculations based on Hybrid Till model with 30% cross subsidization."

Copies of letters dated 30.07.2013 and 14.08.2013 are at **Annexure –I**.

3. Further requests have been received from Government of Karnataka, Ministry of Civil Aviation, and Association of Private Airport Operators vide letters dated 16.08.2013 requesting for extension of time to furnish their views on Consultation Paper (copies of letters at **Annexure – II** collectively). It has, therefore, been decided that the last date for submission of comments on Consultation Paper No. 14/2013-14 dated 26.06.2013 is further extended upto 19.09.2013.

4. All the stakeholders are requested to submit their comments / views on the proposals contained in the Consultation Paper No. 14/2013-14 dated 26.06.2013 **latest by 19.09.2013.**

As you are kindly aware, while submitting the tariff proposal, BIAL had submitted its proposal, based on its interpretation of provisions of Concession Agreement, on Dual Till basis. It also submitted its proposal on Single Till basis only as per directions of the Authority.

While determining UDF for BIAL, MoCA, though of the view that no cross subsidization from non-aeronautical revenue is provided in the Concession Agreement, finalized UDF on the basis of cross subsidization of 30% from non-aero revenue. UDF decided by MoCA in the year 2008/09 was on ad-hoc basis and continued till the commencement of first control period.

BIAL had submitted a letter dated July 5th 2013 to MOCA, as it had granted the concession, reiterating for dual till, based on its interpretation of the concession agreement.

BIAL had been consistently contesting that Concession Agreement does not envisage cross subsidization. However, in order to reach to a workable solution, BIAL intends to agree with the tariff on hybrid till model and accordingly is in the process of submitting calculations based on Hybrid Till model with 30% cross subsidization. It will not be out of place to mention that even with this model, funds requirement of BIAL for expansion and debt repayment might need a special consideration.



This is with reference to Consultation Paper No 14 /2013-14 In the Matter of Determination Tariff for Aeronautical Service In respect of Bangalore International Airport for the Control Period (01-04-2011 to 31-03-2016) issued by Authority on 26 June 2013. The last date fixed for submission for comments / feedback / suggestions from the stakeholders was 5th August 2013 and subsequently extended upto 19th August 2013. We have in fact, requested for extension of additional 3 weeks time for submitting the response to BIAL consultation paper. However, the Authority was kind enough to extend only for 2 weeks, We also notice that the date of submission of Hyderabad Tariff Consultation paper which was running parallelly has now been further extended upto 2nd September 2013. All our member operators are busy in finalizing the Hyderabad paper and will be free to attend the Bangalore consultation paper only after 2nd September 2013 after submitting the responses to the Hyderabad Consultation paper. Further there are few holidays in between due to Janmashtami etc. Since APAO has to necessary consult all members in finalizing its industry submission to the Authority, there is hardly any time left for examining the critical issues relating Bangalore Consultation paper and hence it would not be possible to submit an industry view to the Authority within the date now stipulated .

In view of this we would earnestly request to the Authority to kindly consider providing a further extension of time of an **additional 3 weeks from 19th August 2013** for submission of comments by APAO to the consultation paper 14/2013-14 in respect of Bangalore International Airport.

We would request the Honorable Authority to kindly consider our request favourably.
