Sir,

This has reference to the subject paper circulated by AERA under reference No.AERA/20010/MYTP/Menzies/Cargo/HIAL/2011-12/260 dt. 30.04.2012 regarding Multi Year Tariff Proposal submitted by M/s Hyderabad Menzies Air Cargo Pvt. Ltd. (HMACPL) for services provided for cargo facilities at Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Hyderabad.

Consultation PAPER No.3/2012-13 has been examined and observations of Cargo Department (CHQ) on para 9 of this Consultation Paper are appended below:-

- The cargo facility being provided by M/s HMACPL at Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Hyderabad is "material but not competitive", however, M/s HMACPL has entered into reasonable user agreements and user consultation process is in place. The decision of the Authority to adopt light touch approach for determination of tariff for the first control period w.e.f. 01.04.2011 seems to be in order. Apart from this, AAI has no other comments to offer.
