Sir,

This has reference to the subject Consultation Paper circulated by AERA under reference No.AERA/20010/MYTP-KSIE/TVM/C/2011-12/546 dated 18.06.2012 regarding Annual Tariff Proposal for the Second Tariff Year submitted by M/s Kerala State Industrial Enterprises Limited (KSIE) for services provided for cargo facilities at Thiruananthapuram International Airport, Thiruananthapuram.

M/s KSIE has placed the following proposal for stakeholder consultation:-

The charges determined by the Authority vide Order No. 37/2011-12 dated 14.03.2012 in respect of cargo services provided by M/s KSIE at Thiruananthapuram International Airport may be approved for Second Tariff Year w.e.f. 01.04.2012 and such other prospective date as the Authority may finally decide.

Consultation PAPER No.6/2012-13 has been examined and observations of Cargo Department (CHQ) on Para 5 of the Consultation Paper are appended below:-

Airports Authority of India has allotted land to M/s KSIEL on space rental basis as per the terms & conditions agreed, to handle cargo at Thiruvanthapuram International Airport. Since the Cargo services being rendered by M/s KSIE at Trivandrum Airport is "not material", AERA may adopt 'light touch approach' while deciding the tariff for the second tariff year w.e.f. 01.04.2012. Apart from this, AAI has no comments to offer.

Referring to the above, we have examined the Consultation Paper No.6/2012-13 dated 18.06.2012 issued by the Authority. The circumstances under which the Company had requested the Authority to allow KSIE to continue the same tariff notified for the first tariff year during the 2nd tariff year also and the grounds under which the Authority had proposed to approve the same is very clear from the said Consultation Paper. In fact, as already reported, in respect of Import Cargo Warehousing charges and Export Cargo Terminal charges the Company had allowed some concessions in the rates approved by the Authority for the first tariff year and the same rates are continuing now. As it stands now, there appears to be no valid grounds at all for raising any complaint by any stakeholder against the proposal and we request the Authority to expedite the orders in the matter.
