This has reference to the subject Consultation Paper circulated by AERA under reference No.AERA/20010/MYTP/CSC-PC-Mum/2011-12/Vol.I/6046 dated 23.06.2014 regarding Annual Tariff Proposal for the Fourth Tariff Year (2014-15) of the First Control Period in respect of M/s Cargo Service Centre (CSC) for providing Perishable Cargo Facility at Air Cargo Terminal, CSI Airport, Mumbai.

AERA has considered the proposal submitted by CSC and has issued a Consultation Paper No.06/2014-15 on 16.06.2014, wherein, inter-alia, the following proposals have been placed for stakeholder consultation:-

- iv) The Tariff(s) for the fourth tariff year of the first control period for Cargo Handling Services for perishable cargo provided by Cargo Service Centre India Private Limited at CSI Airport, Mumbai are proposed to be as at Annexure-I of the Consultation Paper.
- v) CSC shall furnish an Auditor Certificate indicating details of actual payment of Customs Cost Recovery and also a confirmation that no penalty component is involved..
- vi) Tariff proposed as above will be maximum and demurrage free period shall be as per Government Orders issued from time to time.


Consultation PAPER No.06/2014-15 has been examined and observations of Cargo Department (CHQ) on Para 04 of the Consultation Paper are appended below:-

"MIAL as an airport operator and custodian controls the cargo operations at CSI Airport, Mumbai. M/s Cargo Service Centre (CSC) is a concessionaire appointed by MIAL through a tendering process to design, develop, manage and operate the second perishable cargo terminal at Mumbai Airport."
