**Subject:** Consultation paper dated Feb 02, 2017 in respect of M/s Bharat Stars Service Private Limited (BSSPL) for Into-Plane Services (ITP) at Bangalore International Airport

This communiqué is with reference to the aforesaid Consultation paper inviting comments/suggestions on the Multi-Year Tariff Proposal (MYTP), and the annual tariff proposal (t1 to t5) for the 2<sup>nd</sup> control period 2016-2021 in respect of M/s Bharat Stars Service Private Limited (BSSPL) for Into-Plane Services (ITP) at Bangalore International Airport (BIAL).

With reference to the proposal contained in Para 5 put forth for stakeholder consultation, M/s Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL), as a stakeholder makes its submissions of a "No Objection" with regard the annual escalation of 5% in the tariff sought by BSSPL in the second control period.

However, as suggested in the past, it is submitted that any levy approved by AERA should only be considered from a prospective date, and that no retrospective recovery of charges should be permitted due to difficulty in recovering these charges from the airlines from a retrospective date.

It is once again requested that the Order, in the matter, considers the submission herein in response hereto.
