The tariff escalation of 5% as proposed by M/s. BSSPL is in line with the earlier approvals granted by the Authority for the First Control Period and as availed by BSSPL during the same period.

Further, it is noted that the proposed escalation is only five percent per annum which is very much required in view of steadily increasing input costs comprising mainly of salary & wages, electricity, diesel and other utilities. Hence the proposed 5% cost escalation per annum for the Second Control Period is justified.

In view of the above, the authority may kindly consider the proposal of BSSPL for approval.
