Subject: Proposal of AAI for Revision of Cargo Tariff at Chennai and Kolkata Airports

With reference to the above, this is to state that subject proposal relates to the charges, viz. Terminal Storage and Processing Charges (TSP) and Demurrage Charges at Chennai and Kolkata airports of AAI and MIAL is not a direct stakeholder in these airports.
